

- 1. Generate lots of TDAmapper outputs for a fixed data set:
 - a. Select knitr for compiling rnw files. Under (1) tools, select global options. Then (2) select Sweave. (3) Change "Weave Rnw files using" to "knitr.



- b. Open beamer-knitr2018_03_22.rnw in Rstudio.
- c. Click on compile pdf and wait a bit to see pdf file of lots of TDAmapper outputs



- d.) Create new artificial data sets to replace the "noisy square" created in lines 7 10. You can use/modify some of the data sets in createArtificalDataSets2.r
- 2.) Cluster some data using clustering.r
- 3.) For fun, play around with imageclustering.r
