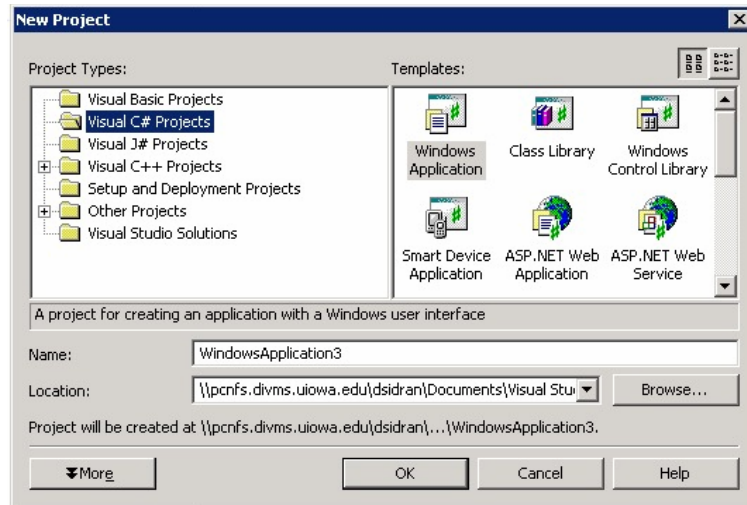


Procedure for submitting assignments in 22C:016.

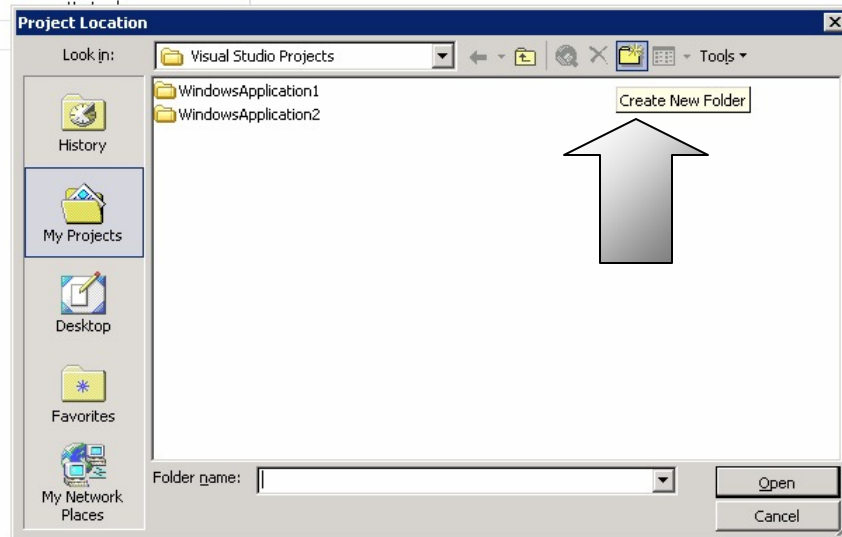
Step 1:

Run Visual Studio.
Select **New Project**. Select **Visual C# Projects**. Select **Visual C# Projects**. Select **Browse**.



Step 2:

Click on the icon for **Create New Folder**.



Step 3:

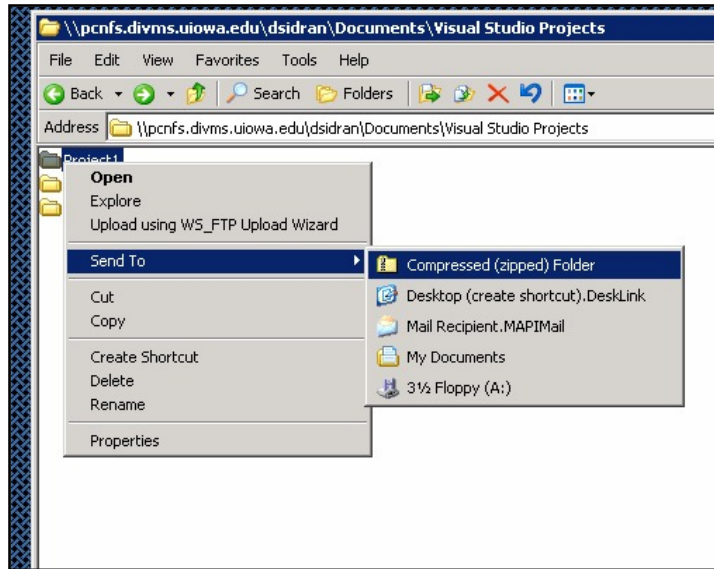
Enter the appropriate name (Project1 for the first group of assignments, for example). Click **OK**. You will now save all of this week's assignments into this folder.



Step 4:

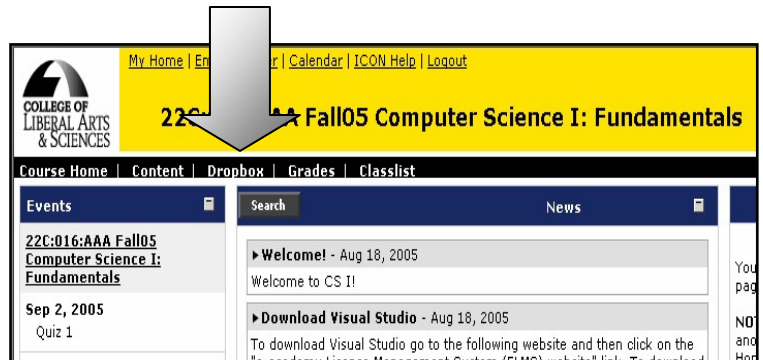
After completing all your assignments you will next compress the folder (in this example Project1). Find your folder (by default it will be in

Documents\Visual Studio Projects) and then **right-click** on the folder. Select **Send To** and then select **Compressed (zipped) Folder**.



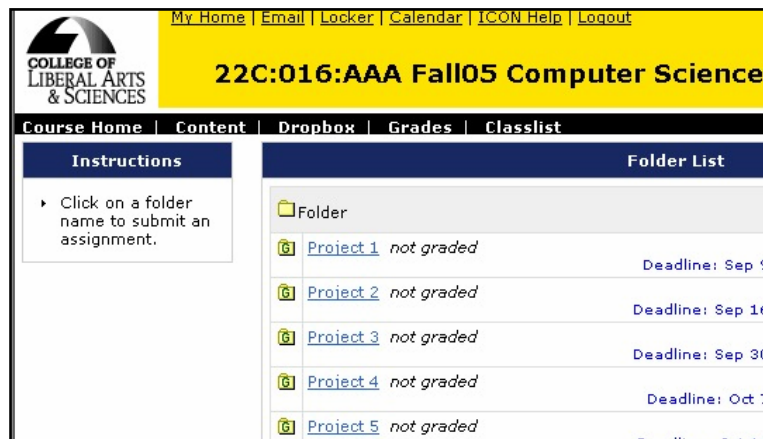
Step 5:

Launch a web browser. Go to **ICON**. Log in. Select **Dropbox**; it is the third item from the left under the course title.



Step 6:

Click on **Project 1** (or whatever the appropriate project number for the week is).

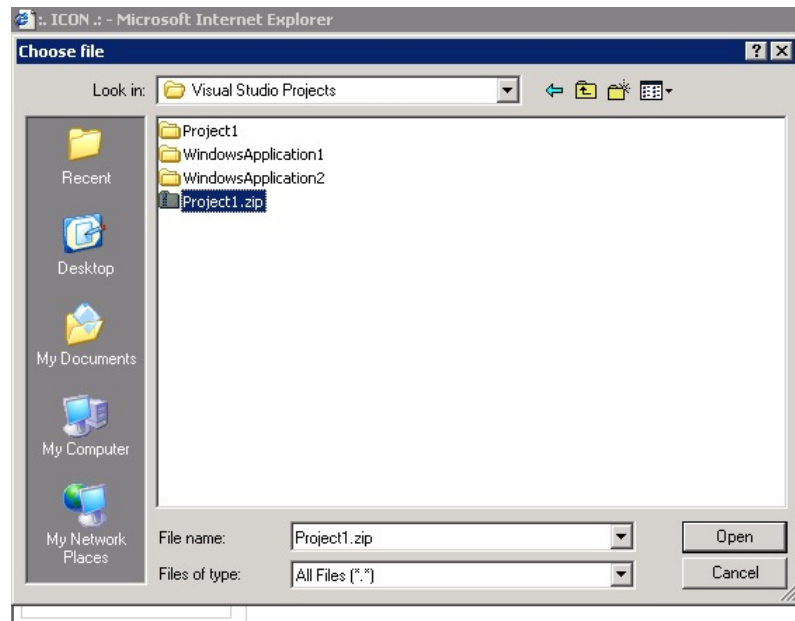
