

Viewing Class Examples


- 1. Log into the Windows Server system through either:
 - Lab 301 in MacLean Hall
 - Remote Desktop Connection
- 2. Open internet explorer and connect to http://icon.uiowa.edu/ and log into ICON as shown below.




You will arrive at your ICON homepage. Under the My ICON Courses section, you will have a list of your classes. Click on the 22C:016:AAA Spr06 Computer Science I link to open the ICON webpage for this class.




4. You will see the webpage for our class. Click on the Content menu item shown on the green menu bar. It is the third choice after Course and Home.



5. A list of dates will appear under Modules corresponding to lectures L1, L2, ... The Course Content shows the Examples for each lecture. Click on Example 1 to view this example.




7. **The first time you download an example you need to follow this procedure.** In order to make sure that you want to download these files from the internet, the system will pop up the following window:




You will need **to click OK** in the dialog box and then click the yellowish information bar with the message "To help protect your security, Internet Explorer blocked this site from downloading files to your computer. Click here for options..." A menu will appear and you need to **select Download File...**


(You may be returned to your main page. Follow the above directions to select Content and click Example to download to reach the next step.)




9. The Save As dialog box will open and allow you to navigate to My Documents/Visual Studio 2005/Projects by clicking the down arrow of the Save in: box. (Red arrow) Then, click on the folder icon with a red dot (green arrow) on its corner to create a New Folder. Give the new folder a name like 22c16 Spr06 Examples and then open it (double click it).



10. You will now be in the new folder. **Click the Save button** to save the Example1.zip file and the Download complete dialog box will appear. After the download is complete **click Open Folder** to find the downloaded file.




11. The folder containing the downloaded file will appear. Right click on the file name to see a menu of options. Select the Extract All option to run the Extraction Wizard. Click Next of the wizard.



12. **Select a directory for the extraction** (default is ok). (You should use the default if it shows the directory created above. The directory will be as follows if you used the above choices: \pcnfs.divms.uiowa.edu\userid\Documents\Visual Studio 2005\Projects\22c016S06 Examples\Example




13. **Click Next** to extract the file (blue line appears through the Extracting... bar). Click Finish to complete the extraction





14. You will see the extracted files in your selected directory double click the directory to see the contents



15. **Double click on Example 1.sln** (or the file name with the extension .sln for your specific download).

If you are viewing Examples 1, 2, or 3, you will be sent to the Visual Studio Conversion Wizard. Follow the directions to covert to Visual Studio 2005 for viewing. All later examples will be in Visual Studio 2005 format.



16. The example will open in Visual Studio 2005. Click on Form1.cs to view the design of the form. The project is now in your personal version of Visual Studio for you to use. Have fun!
