  - Chapters 1-5, 7-9
  - more detailed breakdown of types of data (binary, nominal, ordinal, quantitative discrete, quantitative continuous)
- Questions will be mostly short answer and multiple choice. Some will involve interpreting SAS output that I will provide.
- You may bring:
  - one 8-1/2 x 11 sheet of paper with your own notes (you may write on both sides)
