

Transportation during the conference

Radisson hotel shuttle. The hotel offers a complimentary (free) shuttle to the Iowa City downtown (including the math department, Maclean Hall). It carries up to 12 people and you schedule this directly with the front desk. In the evening, you can call to be picked up and taken back to the hotel.

--If you use this for transportation to the conference in the morning, I highly recommend scheduling it the night before and tell them you need to be at the conference site at least 15 minutes before the first talk. *The shuttle does not run on Saturday due to the football game.*

Rideshare apps. Both Lyft and Uber are available in the Iowa City/Coralville area and usually more economical than taxis.

Traditional Taxi. There are a number of taxi services available. The only one I have ever used is Marco's Taxi. 319-337-TAXI <http://www.marcostraxi.com/>

Personal or rental car. The closest parking garage to Maclean Hall is the Capitol Street Garage, 19 E Burlington St. You can walk from your car through the garage into the adjoining mall and walk through the mall most of the way to Maclean Hall. This is nice if weather is bad. Two other close parking garages are the Dubuque Street Garage, 220 S Dubuque St, and the Iowa Ave garage, 335 Iowa Ave. Their cost is \$1/hour with the first hour free. Street parking is metered near campus, usually with 1 or 2 hour limits. One can look for free street parking about a 10 minute walk from Maclean hall, starting east of Johnson St. The garages are marked with **P** below, with the arrow indicating directions of entrance. Maclean Hall at left is the conference site.
