- **R** is a popular programming language for data wrangling and visualization
- Many packages collections of functions available through central CRAN repository
- Link: https://www.r-project.org/

- **mappeR** is an R package available on CRAN which implements the Mapper algorithm.
- It is meant to succeed Paul Pearson's TDAMapper package, which is no longer being updated and was removed from CRAN in 2022.

- Shiny is a web framework for developing applications in R (and recently, Python).
